SCHOOL

Westminster Christian Academy, established in 1989, is an independent college-preparatory school. Located in Watkinsville, Georgia. The school serves approximately 365 students in preschool through twelfth grade. Current enrollment in the high school is 105 students.

ACCREDITATION

Westminster Christian Academy is fully accredited by SAIS/AdvancED. Westminster holds membership in the Georgia Independent School Association, the Southern Association of Independent Schools, and the National Association of Secondary School Principals.

GRADING SYSTEM

The high school operates on a two-semester academic year, utilizing a combination of daily 45-minute class periods. A semester consists of one eighteen-week grading period, concluding with a semester examination that constitutes 20% of the semester grade. Advanced Placement courses are not weighted.

Courses earn one-half of a unit of credit each semester.

Grading Scale: A = 90-100 (4 points), B = 80-89 (3 points), C = 70-79 (2 points), F = Below 70 (0 points)

RIGOR OF CURRICULUM

Our school's smaller size dictates a focused approach to curriculum and instruction. Therefore, with the exception of Advanced Placement classes, Westminster offers only one academic level, which is designed to meet or exceed the quality of instruction one might find at the honors level in schools with multiple academic tracks. Course objectives and expectations for student performance are also comparable to the honors track in larger schools. The Advanced Placement classes offered at Westminster are Art, Biology, Chemistry, Calculus AB, English Literature and Composition, Latin, Spanish, and US History.

CLASS RANK

Westminster does not report the rank of individual students. Our classes are small and academically competitive, and ranking does not provide a fair and accurate measure of student performance or ability.

SENIOR SAT SCORES

Westminster students consistently score above the state and national averages on the SAT. All student's scores are reported. (2018 State and National scores are not yet released 2017 averages are reported)
